PHYSICAL DEMANDS AND WORK ENVIRONMENT

Physical Demands:

- Bending legs downward and forward by bending leg and spine.
- Ascending or descending stairs, ramps and the like, using feet and legs and/or hands and arms.
- Ascending or descending ladders, scaffolding, poles and the like, using feet and legs and/or hands and arms.
- Raising objects from a lower to higher position or moving object horizontally from position to position.
- Perceiving size, shape, temperature, or texture by touching with skin, particularly the fingertips
- Moving about on foot to accomplish tasks, particularly for long distances.
- Standing, particularly for sustained periods of time.
- Using upper extremities to exert force to draw, drag, haul or tug objects in a sustained motion.
- Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally to lift, carry, pull, or otherwise move objects.
- Perceiving the nature of sounds with or without correction, to receive detailed information through oral communication, and to make fine discrimination in sound, such as when making fine adjustments on equipment or machines
- Substantial movements (motion) of the wrist, hands, and/or fingers in a repetitive manner
- Close vision (clear vision at 20 inches or less)
- Distance vision (clear vision at 20 feet or more)
- Color Vision (ability to identify and distinguish colors)
- Peripheral vision (ability to observe an area that can be seen up and down or to the left and right while eyes are fixed on a given point)
- Depth perception (there-dimensional vision, ability to judge distances and spatial relationships)
- Ability to adjust focus (ability to adjust the eye to bring an object into sharp focus)

Work Environment: Outdoors exposed to changing weather conditions (for instance, rain, sun, snow, wind, etc.)

- Air contamination (i.e., dust, fume, smoke, toxic conditions, disagreeable odors)
- Exposed to vibrations (i.e. operating jackhammer, impact wrench)
- Wet to humid conditions (non-weather)
- Work near moving mechanical parts
- Work in high, precarious places, where the possibility of falling exists
- Fumes or airborne particles
- Toxic or caustic chemicals
- Extreme cold or extreme heat (non-weather)
- Very loud work environment
- Regular Office schedule, Monday – Friday, 7:00am – 3:30pm
- Occasional overnight travel (up to 20%) by land and/or air
